*Copal Painting Medium (Optional)
*Liquin (Optional)

## ODERLESS Paint Thinner with Sealable Container

Portable Easel (French Field or Backpack).
Palette: 12"x16" minimum with Sealable Blue lid or French Mistress
Disposable Palette Paper is fine, (I use glass as a palette)
Paper Towels/trash bags
Boards and/or canvas sizes: $6 \times 8,8 \times 10,9 \times 12,11 \times 14,12 \times 16$
Carrier for Wet Oil paintings (Optional)

Hogs hair bristle brushes: \#2, \#4, \#6, \#8. Flat or Filbert
Cheap Larger 2" Brush
Paper Towels/trash bag
Throw away palette paper
6x8 to $12 \times 16$ size canvas/board Field Easel/French easel/
or tripod with pochade box (small, enclosed palette)
